

Availability of \$1,000 in Grant Money for Conducting Research on Cognitive CoachingSM

The Research and Development Committee of Thinking Collaborative is pleased to announce the availability of grant money up to \$1,000 for conducting research on Cognitive CoachingSM. The grant will be awarded at the Thinking Collaborative Leadership Symposium that will be held January 28, 2015 in Denver, Colorado. You will not need to be present to receive the grant. The grant will be for one year, beginning with the Symposium. Proposals will be accepted by Jenny Edwards (jedwards@fielding.edu) until December 31, 2014 and will be evaluated based on the greatest potential for advancing the field of Cognitive CoachingSM.

To apply for the grant, please submit the following, not to exceed seven pages (resume and references are not included in the seven pages):

- Your contact information and affiliation (school name, etc.)
- Resume
- Title of the proposed study
- Amount requested
- An abstract of the proposed study
- Rationale describing the need for the study
- Research methods, including research questions, setting, participants, instruments, procedures, and methods for analyzing the data
- Anticipated outcomes of the study
- A description of how this study will contribute to the field of Cognitive CoachingSM
- A budget with an itemized list of all expected expenses
- Timeline for the completion of the study
- Anticipated date by which you will submit the findings
- Plan for disseminating the findings
- Permission from your organization to conduct the study
- If you are planning on publishing, permission from the Institutional Review Board (IRB) of your school or university
- Names and credentials of others with whom you will be working on the study, if any
- References cited in the proposal
