Facilitator Moves

PROCESS

- Distribute a playing card to each individual (Jack = 11, Queen = 12, King = 13, Ace = 1)
- Ask people to stand, find others with cards appropriate to the patterns below, gather their materials, and sit together.

ALTERNATIVES

- Pairs — same number, same color
- Pairs — same number, different color
- Pairs — same number, different color, different suit from last time
- Pairs — cards add up to 14 (same color)
- Pairs — cards add up to 14 (different color)
- Three — cards add up to 21 (same suit, different suit)
- Four — four of a kind
- Five — best poker hands (can do a number of times)

cont.

- Any number— form into runs: same suits, same color, different color
- Four groups — by suit
- Other combinations limited only by your imagination

TIP

- Shuffle or consciously arrange cards to break up cliques or table groups.
