Information Process: Exploring and Discovering

PROCESS

- Prepare interview-recording sheets, one for each question.
- Form groups of six, each person with one question.
- Round 1: Write a response to your own question in the top space.
- Round 2: 1 and 2 interview each other; 3 and 4 interview each other; 5 and 6 interview each other.
- Round 3: 1 and 3; 2 and 5; 4 and 6.
- Round 4: 1 and 4; 2 and 6; 3 and 5.
- Round 5: 1 and 5; 2 and 4; 3 and 6.
- Round 6: 1 and 6; 2 and 3, 4 and 5.
- Join others with the same question.
- Share the responses and create a synthesizing statement.
- Be prepared to share your statement with the large group

ALTERNATIVES

- Form groups of four, each person with one question.
- Have groups create a graphic, rather than a statement, to share with the large group.

TIPS

- Provide a recording page for each question, six spaces on each page.
- Make sure the questions are open-ended and varied.
