

Close the Discussion

Decisions

PROCESS

- The person in charge displays decision options.
 - Participants can vote on whether to keep the discussion going or not.
 - The person in charge decides whether to end the discussion or extend it.
 - Everyone has one more chance to make a point.
 - Continue the discussion but limit it to a specific topic.
 - Close the discussion if someone calls for closure and two others agree.
 - Delegate the decision making to a subgroup.
 - Talk until a predetermined time limit has been reached. The person in charge makes an executive decision if the group hasn't decided by then.
- The members explore advantages and drawbacks of each option.
- The group selects an option to use on a regular basis.

ALTERNATIVES

- The group selects a few options for consideration when approaching a decision
