PROCESS

- Read a selection of text and make connections to some aspect of your work.
- In groups, share some of your connections.
- Honor the spirit of inquiry with pausing, paraphrasing, and inquiring

ALTERNATIVES

- Assign this to trios instead of a group.

TIPS

- Review the principles of dialogue prior to starting this process.
- Because not listening is a common default pattern, you might want to periodically stop the action and ask people to notice what is happening in the conversation, or engage them in the Round-Robin Reflection described in this appendix.
