

Scrambled Sentences

Information Processing: Activating and Engaging, Organizing and Integrating

PROCESS

- Each person writes one word on a card or sticky note illustrative of the individual's learning.
- The group constructs a sentence that uses all the words, while adding as few new words as possible.
- Group spokespeople read the sentences to the full group.

ALTERNATIVES

- Write words for a common experience.
- After creating one sentence, have the participants take their word and form another group, creating another sentence.

TIPS

- Give a signal for the group work to begin.
