PROCESS

- Members read and mark text for purposes, such as:
 - √Affirms prior knowledge
 - o! Surprises you
 - o ? You wish to know more about this

Within small groups and in round-robin fashion, members explore the items they marked.

Each member shares only one item at a time.

• Explore only items marked as ! or ?.

ALTERNATIVES

- Change the prompts to fit the purpose of the task. Other prompts might include the following: what concerns you, what excites you, what neither concerns nor excites you.
- Members read the text before the meeting when possible.
